



Happy memories a big lure

WHILE auctions ground to a halt over the Christmas-New Year period, it has been off-the-plan projects chalking up the sales.

After honeymooning at Binna Burra Mountain Lodge 30 years ago, Greg and Alison

Lewis couldn't resist the chance to buy a Sky Lodge apartment in the heart of the World Heritage-listed Lamington National Park.

The Toowoomba couple have been holidaying at Binna Burra ever since their

honeymoon and spent the recent Christmas and New Year there as well.

They have bought lot 15 - a two bedroom lodge - for \$805,000.

Sky Lodge project manager Tim Medhurst said 11 of the 18

apartments, which are now under construction, have been sold. The highest price achieved to date was \$1.08 million for a three-bedroom, dual-key apartment.

He said many were buying for sentimental reasons with

buyers coming mainly from Brisbane suburbs, although there was a Melbourne and Canberra buyer also in the mix.

Mr Medhurst said the sales price included a furniture package.
